In November 2022, RRH began serving patients from a new 140,000-square-foot medical campus, replacing a nearly 45-year-old hospital nearing the end of its usage. The surgical center and related capabilities were critical when designing the new facility, resulting in the specialized department.

Boasting a much-needed larger space, the new surgical center integrates new equipment, larger surgical suites, and a comfortable family waiting area. Much, if not most, of the department's equipment is brand new, bringing enhanced capabilities with the new hospital.

Many procedures at RRH may be performed with endoscopes or laparoscopes, which enable the surgeon to see inside the body without making large incisions. The benefits of these techniques include shorter hospital stays and recovery times. For some procedures, open surgery may still be the best option.

Many common general procedures can be performed at RRH, including laparoscopic gallbladder

surgeries, laparoscopic appendectomies, laparoscopy and open hernia repairs, soft tissue tumors, circumcision, vasectomy, endoscopy, colonoscopy along with other minor and major procedures.

According to Subhash Nagalla, MD, FACS, a general surgeon in Pecos, many patients delay having elective surgeries for various reasons. He says even the slightest delay could prolong pain and discomfort or cause additional physical harm.

Dr. Nagalla says it is best to follow your medical provider's recommendations when it comes to elective surgery.

Choosing the right facility is also essential when deciding to have surgery. Dr. Nagalla says convenience is why local patients should choose RRH. He explains traveling to larger cities for common procedures is not necessary. Dr. Nagalla, completed his general surgery residency in New York and his fellowship in minimally invasive surgery at Cleveland Clinic in Florida.

He has been in practice for over 14 years and in West Texas for over 10 years.
