Reeves County Healthcare Providers Celebrated During National Doctors' Day

Celebrations continue with Annual Health Fair April 1.

PECOS, Texas (March 24, 2023) – Medical providers are the cornerstone of every hospital and clinic, providing essential services to keep our communities healthy. To celebrate the fantastic work of our local physicians, Reeves Regional Health (RRH) is honoring local physicians on March 30 as part of a nationwide observance of National Doctors' Day.

"The last several years have been interesting for us in the healthcare industry. I think I speak for everyone here at Reeves Regional when I say that our local physicians have been a solid guiding light in advancing local healthcare," says Brenda McKinney, CEO of RRH. "Helping our patients through a myriad of conditions, the medical providers in Reeves County never skipped a beat in treating and caring for our community."

National Doctors' Day was first observed on March 30, 1933. Inspired by the anniversary of the first use of anesthesia by Dr. Crawford W. Long in 1842, Eudora Brown Almond, wife of Dr. Charles B. Almond, proposed the celebration to show appreciation for doctors everywhere.

The US House of Representatives passed a resolution in 1958 to commemorate the occasion. With congressional approval in 1990, President George H.W. Bush signed a resolution officially designating March 30 as National Doctors' Day.

Healthcare providers at RRH, which includes the hospital and Reeves Regional Rural Health Clinic, offer various healthcare services. Those who need healthcare don't have to travel out of the region. Local providers at RRH specialize in multiple areas, including family practice, internal medicine, general surgery, obstetrics and gynecology, and nephrology.

While many rural communities across Texas have gone without local healthcare services, Reeves County continues to thrive with the availability of convenient and comprehensive medical programs and services.

RRH recently celebrated the opening of its 40,000-square-foot medical campus, replacing a nearly 45-year-old hospital nearing the end of its usage. Nearly doubling the footprint of its old facility, the new campus includes more space for providers, patients, and staff; modern amenities; and upgraded technology.
