Pecos Rural Health Clinic Reminds Patients of Saturday Hours

Holiday Schedule Update: Clinic Closed July 4th, Open July 5th and July 6th

PECOS, Texas (July 1, 2024) – Reeves Regional Rural Health Clinic (RRRHC) reminds the community that its Saturday clinic hours, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, continue to provide convenient access to medical care on the weekend. These Saturday hours cater to patients needing prompt attention for acute conditions without an appointment.

The RRRHC will be closed on July 4th in observance of Independence Day but will resume regular hours on Friday, July 5th. The Saturday clinic will be open as usual on July 6th.

Conchita Hernandez, Practice Manager at RRRHC, emphasized the importance of these weekend hours, stating, "Our Saturday clinic has been a vital resource for patients who need care outside of the typical workweek. We are committed to providing accessible and flexible healthcare options to meet the needs of our community."

The Saturday clinic is designed to address acute medical issues such as coughs, colds, sore throats, and minor injuries, ensuring that community members receive timely care without disrupting their weekday schedules.

"We know that life doesn't stop on the weekends," Hernandez added. "Whether it's a sudden illness or a minor injury, our team is here to support our patients when they need it most, even on Saturdays."

RRRHC's extended hours are part of its ongoing dedication to enhancing healthcare accessibility in Reeves County. The clinic remains steadfast in its mission to deliver comprehensive and convenient healthcare services to all residents.

Reeves Regional Rural Health Clinic, under the umbrella of Reeves Regional Health, offers a variety of medical services, including family practice, preventive care, surgical consultations, obstetrics services, and care for minor emergencies. Patients can also schedule preventive care appointments Monday through Friday, ensuring year-round access to wellness exams and screenings.

The clinic advocates for preventive health measures to catch potential issues early. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) highlights that regular health exams and screenings can
